



## JD.com Entering into Definitive Agreements to Invest in Aihuishou

JD.com, Inc. (the “Company”), China’s leading technology driven e-commerce company and retail infrastructure service provider, has entered into definitive agreements to invest in Aihuishou, an online second-hand consumer electronics trading platform. JD.com will merge its Paipai Secondhand business into Aihuishou with certain exclusive traffic resources for the next five years, and additionally invest approximately US\$20 million in cash in exchange for a non-controlling interest in Aihuishou.
