




Net Product Revenues Breakdown




Net Service Revenues Breakdown

Diversified Businesses in a Wide Spectrum of Sectors





New businesses mainly include JD Property, Jingxi, overseas businesses and technology initiatives.

Resilient Core Profitability with the Benefits of Scale








